

# Puppy Shopping List

Below is a basic list of items you may want to purchase as you prepare to bring your puppy home.

### Shopping list:

- Food-Purina Pro Plan large breed puppy
- NuVet vitamins
- Food and water bowls\*
- Small treats for training
- Crate\*\*
- Old towels or blankets for bedding
- Leash & collar with ID tags
- Durable chew toys\*\*\*
- Nail trimmers
- Dog shampoo
- Grooming brush
- Dog tooth brush and enzymatic toothpaste
- Floor cleaner/ odor remover
- Poop scoop or poop bags for cleanup
- Baby gates or pet exercise yard, if necessary
- Training clicker, if using this method
- Treat pouch- ie PetSafe Treat Pouch Sport

### Research list:

- Local veterinarian.
- Location of nearest ER veterinarian.
- County or city dog license regulations.
- Microchip registration (once you bring the puppy home).
- Local puppy classes or dog trainer.

\*Slow feeders can be very helpful for Labrador puppies. We recommend a slow feeder for your puppy.

\*\*We use either Large 42" or Extra large 48" single door crates for our adult dogs. Our crates are purchased from Amazon.com. For puppies, we purchase a large crate and utilize the divider to create a smaller space when the puppy is small and adjust as they grow.. We line the crate with an old towel or blanket that is easily cleaned if a young puppy soils it.
