-Food-Purina Pro Plan Large Breed Puppy / when adults (2 years old) transition to Purina Pro Plan Large Breed Chicken & Rice.

- -Food and water bowls\*
- -Small treats for training
- -Crate\*\*
- -Old towels or blankets for bedding
- -Leash & collar with ID tags
- -Durable chew toys\*\*\*
- -Nail trimmers
- -Dog shampoo
- -Floor cleaner/ odor remover
- -Baby gates or pet exercise yard, if necessary
- -Training clicker, if using this method
- -Treat pouch-ie PetSafe Treat Pouch Sport

## **Research list:**

- -Location of nearest ER veterinarian.
- -County or city dog license regulations.
- -Local puppy classes or dog trainer.

\*Slow feeders can be very helpful for Labrador puppies. We recommend a slow feeder for your puppy. \*\*We use either Large 42" or Extra large 48" single door crates for our adult dogs. Our crates are purchased from Amazon.com. For puppies, we purchase a large crate and utilize the divider to create a smaller space when the puppy is small and adjust as they grow. We line the crate with an old towel or blanket that is easily cleaned if a young puppy soils it.
